First-time ABRCMS judges (postdoctoral scientists and faculty members) available to judge all poster and oral sessions scheduled throughout the conference are eligible to apply for the Judges' Travel Subsidy. Awardees must be active researchers in one of the ten scientific disciplines represented at the conference. The subsidy provides one conference registration (which includes all scheduled meals, conference materials, closing banquet and access to all sessions) and housing for 4 nights at the conference hotel. Awardees are responsible for all travel related expenses.
