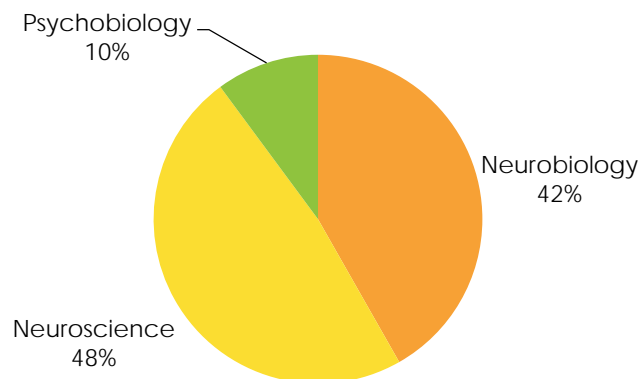

In 2018....

- 268 abstracts were submitted in Neuroscience
- 11% of all abstracts were in Neuroscience
- On-site, 70 judges were used to review 240 Neuroscience poster & oral presentations
- 33 students won presentation awards in Neuroscience
